### Orientation Information Table

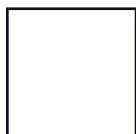

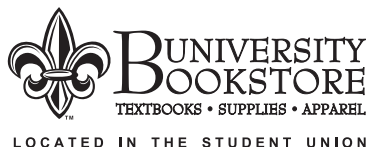
